- a) Contribution towards community library project (£500 already committed by Parish Council)
- b) Dog litter bins – Ferry Lane suggested
- c) Railings on high parts of the pavement
- d) Traffic calming and safety measures in the village
- e) Bench at junction of Biggs lane and main road
- f) Bench at top of Green Lane, view across Hawkers Lane
- g) Bench at Cherry Hill near Keeper's Cottage
- h) Planting of spring bulbs and autumn cyclamen corms at sites around the village
- i) Picnic table near pond on Recreation Field
- j) Picnic table near skateboard ramp on Recreation Field
- k) Planter in front of Fownhope sign at the entrance to the village
- l) New village sign (sketches provided) – to incorporate village images
- m) Contribution to Room for All (£5000 already committed by the Parish Council)
- n) Purchase of grit and contractors for clearing snow (£600 already committed by Parish Council)
- o) Repair of memorial inscription to Tom Spring
